The Energy Authority Welcomes New Customers

JACKSONVILLE, FL (Feb. 12, 2007) -- The Energy Authority (TEA) is happy to announce the addition of two new Resource Management Partners to its customer base. The Massachusetts Municipal Wholesale Electric Company (MMWEC) and the Klickitat Public Utility District recently signed contracts with TEA. MMWEC will receive support in financial hedging while Klickitat has contracted for power supply management and real-time trading support.

MMWEC is the joint-action agency for Massachusetts municipal utilities. It is a nonprofit, public corporation and political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts that provides a variety of wholesale power supply, financial and other services to the state's consumer-owned municipal utilities. Of the 40 municipal utilities in Massachusetts, 25 are Members of MMWEC and 28 are MMWEC Project Participants.

Klickitat Public Utility District is a municipal corporation of the State of Washington formed by a vote of the citizens of Klickitat County in 1938. It is a customer-owned utility, committed to providing electricity on a cost of service basis as a customer service, not to make a profit for stockholders. The Klickitat PUD serves 10,000 customers on 1,600 miles of line.
